Turkey Tetrazzini

“This easy pasta dish is a great way to use the turkey leftovers - and a Parmesan lover’s dream!”



Prep Time: 20 Minutes • Cook Time: 1 Hour
Ready In: 1 Hour 20 Minutes
Servings: 8 • Servings Per Recipe: 8

Ingredients:

| 1 (16 ounce) package uncooked spaghetti | 3 cups chicken broth |
| ½ cup butter | 2 cups milk |
| ½ cup all-purpose flour | 1 ² / ₃ cups grated Parmesan cheese |
| | 4 cups chopped cooked turkey |

Directions:

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Lightly grease a medium baking dish.
- Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Add spaghetti, and cook for 8 to 10 minutes or until al dente. Drain, and place in the prepared baking dish.
- Melt butter in a medium saucepan over medium heat. Stir in flour. Mix in chicken broth and milk. Cook and stir until the mixture comes to a boil. Stir in about 1¹/₃ cups Parmesan cheese, and remove from heat.
- Mix chicken broth mixture and turkey with spaghetti. Top with remaining cheese. Bake 1 hour in the preheated oven, until surface is lightly browned.
