**Sweet Barbecue  
Sandwiches**

*This tangy and sweet sauce  
can be used on pulled pork or  
shredded beef for a hearty  
warm sandwich.*



**Ingredients**

- 2 tbsp. oil
- 1 medium onion, diced
- 2 tbsp vinegar
- 1 tbsp worcestershire sauce
- 4 tbsp brown sugar
- 1 bottle chili sauce
- ½ cup water
- 3-4 pound beef or pork roast

**Directions**

Bake pork roast or beef roast until done, allow to cool  
slightly then pull/cut apart.

While roast is cooking, prepare barbecue sauce. Sauté  
onions in oil, then add remaining ingredients. Simmer for  
ten minutes.

Place meat in shallow baking dish and cover with sauce.  
Bake for at least 40 minutes at 325° or until bubbling.

Serve on roll or bread of your choice.
